## Urinary tract infection in men ESBL-E related Prostatitis\*

- Antibiotic treatment: (to be adapted according to body weight and creatinine clearance, see table on Medical Kit tab: antimicrobial protocols)
  - ciprofloxacine 500mg tb bid (if bacterial agent susceptible to nalidixic acid)
  - cotrimoxazole 800 mg bid
  - Course duration: acute (2 wks) vs chronic (see below)
- If these antibiotics cannot be used or in case of chronic prostatitis, request expert advice, as other agents have poor prostatic tissue concentration. Parenteral administration will be necessary.
- Infection control measures
- Patient information

<sup>\*</sup>If no signs of severity (fever, urine retention), wait for urine culture results before treating
